**Amanda man
killed after
car strikes
power pole**

An Amanda man was killed Saturday evening after the car in which he was a passenger struck a power pole, according to a news release from Fairfield County Sheriff's Office.

Terry L. Stewart, 40, of Amanda, was in a vehicle driven by David L. Griffith, 29, of Amanda, traveling eastbound on Hamburg Road in Hocking Township at about 9:05 p.m. Saturday.

Griffith lost control of the car, and it went off the right side of the road, sliding broadside into a power pole and snapping the pole in half, according to the news release.

The car continued on into a tree, coming to a rest on its top in two pieces, according to the release.

Stewart was transported to Fairfield Medical Center by MedFlight. Griffith was transported to Fairfield Medical Center by the Amanda Squad, where the sheriff's office release said he was listed in stable condition Sunday morning. Fairfield Medical Center would not release information about the accident or patient conditions Sunday. No citations were issued.
