NARRATIVE

Dispatched to Lancaster Sand and Gravel on a mutual aid call to assist Berne Twp Fire Department on a dredge that was on fire. We (EC-1) were first on the scene with Acting Lt. Primmer in charge, a portable deluge was set up at the edge of the lake to attempt to reach and control the fire.

At this same time Berne equipment arrived along with Berne Firefighter Mike Smith who assumed command. A water supply was established using Berne equipment to supply EC-1 from a portable tank.

AFFF foam was applied via the deluge gun. Firefighters Primmer and Downhour then approached the dredge in a boat using a foam applicator to extinguish the fire. 200 ft. of 1 3/4 inch hose and 100 ft of 5in hose.were used. Berne Twp FD supplied 15 gallons of foam.

Additional Lancaster Fire Personnel on the scene were Inspectors Burnside and Lt Anders who responded with spill control equipment.

A/C Sells and A/C Campbell who assisted with logistics, supply, and safety.
