Fuel spill on Diley Road on June 30, 1998. Approximately 50-60 gallons of diesel and hydraulic fluid on the road surface as well as the drainage ditch with extensive soil contamination. Violet Fire was able to dike and dam a large quantity of the product, however approximately 100-150 feet of the ditch was contaminated. The accident happened on a slight uphill grade
