NARRATIVE

E551 CALLED ON A SERVICE RUN ON AN NON INJURY ACCIDENT. TRUCK LEAKING OIL. UPON ARRIVAL FOUND SEMI TRACTOR HAD HIT A LARGE ROCK AND BROKE THE VEHICLE'S OIL PAN. DRIVER SHAWN REESE HAD MOVE VEHICLE TO SIDE OF ROAD TO DISCONNECT TRAILER THEN MOVED VEHICLE TO DRIVEWAY BEHIND BAY'S IGA. OIL HAD LEAKED ON ROADWAY AND ON TO GRAVEL DRIVEWAY. E551 CREW USED 7 (40 POUND) BAGS OF OIL DRY TO CONTAIN AND ABSORB OIL ON ROADWAY AND GRAVEL DRIVEWAY. THE DRIVER HAD ALREADY CALLED HIS COMPANY FOR ASSISTANCE, LT REIS CALLED THE EPA TO REPORT SPILL. INITIALLY TALKED TO KELLY @ 1645 AND GAVE HER THE INFORMATION. GAVIN ARMSTRONG FROM THE EPA CALLED BACK AND STATED THAT WE HAD DONE EVERYTHING THERE WAS TO DO. NO OIL SPILLED INTO ANY WATER WAY. MR ARMSTRONG ADVISED US TO MAKE SURE ALL ABSORBANT WAS CLEANED UP AND DISPOSED OF BY THE TOWING COMPANY. E551 CREW STAYED ON THE SCENE UNTIL ALL CLEANUP WAS COMPLETED.
