
Dear Mr. Duda:

NARRATIVE

WASTE MANAGEMENT TRUCK BROKE A HYDRAULIC OIL LINE. SPILLED APPROX 25 GALLONS OF OIL ON THE ROAD. SOME WENT INTO ROAD DITCH AND ACROSSED A DRIVEWAY. DRIVER SHUT OFF TRUCK TO STOP THE OIL FLOW. HE CALLED THE SHOP IN CANAL WINCHESTER, THEY BROUGHT BAGS OF FLOOR DRY OUT TO THE SCENE. THEY SPREAD OIL DRY ALL OVER ROAD WAY TO ABSORB THE OIL.

SAFETY MANAGER RONALD DUDA WAS ON SCENE. HE STATED THEY BRING A CLEAN UP CONTRACTOR IN TO CLEAN THE MESS UP. FIREFIGHTER SCOTT BAKER SPOKE WITH TODD TAYLOR FROM THE OHIO EPA AND ADVISED THEM OF THE SPILL AND HOW IT WAS BEING CLEANED UP. HE WAS OK WITH EVERYTHING THAT HAD BEEN DONE.
