Dear Chief

Per our recent conversation regarding the NFIRs report on an incident that occurred in your jurisdiction.

The incident took place between 7585 and 7605 Chillicothe-Lancaster Road on May 9, 2000. I took the call for the incident at about 10:30 am. On the scene from your department were Rescue 516, Medic 512 and Grass 514 with a total of 7 personnel. The incident involved a semi dump truck hauling a large amount of sandy material that turned out to be hazardous waste. The truck was over weight and not correctly registered. The vehicle was owned by RIE Painting out of Lancaster and was headed to the landfill.

The entire incident is still under investigation by Ohio EPA's representatives.

I am requesting a copy of the report, whether it is NFIRs or a written report from your department on the incident so that we may complete our files. We are requesting this in the event any litigation comes from the outcome of the investigation. You may either send it or fax it to me.

Dear Mr. Bolger:

REI Construction has reviewed all available inform regarding the release of an unknown hazardous or non-hazardous substance on the roadway between 7585 & 7605 Chillicothe-Lancaster Road.

We have concluded that the release of any hazardous material if any would have been substantially less then reported quantities. Therefore, it is my understanding that reporting to Federal, State, Local Agencies is not required. The sand that the truck was carrying is not hazardous waste. Analytical work is enclosed. Any liquids that dripped out of the trailer onto the roadway would have been 98% water. Discolored by the filtration through the sand. It is believed the total amount dripped from the trailer was a relatively small amount, i.e. less than five (5) gallons and most likely less than one (1) gallon.
