7:15 pm I received a page from Eric Smith on duty @ Bloom Twp. I called back, he informed me he received a call from Barb Johnson-Johnson Tools 4240 Old Col's Rd. Carroll OH 43112. She was attempting to report that she had accidentally emptied a drum filled  $\frac{2}{3}$  full of gasoline/diesel/water onto the parking lot surface next to her building. She was wanting a way to get rid of the odor, or clean it up.

7:30 Left for Johnson tool and arrived a short time later to find a plastic 55 gal. drum with a small amount of product in the bottom. It was sitting next to an area about 6' x 10' that was saturated with the product. It had also splashed upon the building. The owners estimated  $\frac{1}{2}$  to  $\frac{2}{3}$  full. 25-30 gallons in my estimate.

8:15pm I called EPA to have field rep. call me. Chris Holmes from EPA called me back and informed me that they could do a local clean up with no contaminated gravel/soil to leave property. I instructed them to build a large visqueen pool area and have gravel/dirt dumped in it. I also told them to aerate the gravel/soil for at least 10 days and once the contaminants had.

NARRATIVE

RECEIVED A CALL FROM STA 551, E. SMITH, REFERENCE THEY RECEIVED A CALL FROM THE OWNER OF JOHNSON TOOL. BARB JOHNSON ADVISED THAT SHE HAD SPILLED A 55 GALLON DRUM OF WHAT SHE THOUGHT WAS WATER. IT WAS HOWEVER, A MIXTURE OF WATER, GAS, DIESEL FUEL. E. SMITH WENT AHEAD AND CALLED SCOTT BAKER, FAIRFIELD CO. E.M.A. HE SAID HE TRIED CALLING CHIEF UNDERWOOD, BUT THERE WAS NO ANSWER. MR. BAKER WAS GOING TO THE SCENE. I WENT DOWN ALSO. THERE HAD BEEN A SPILL APPROX. 8FT X 12FT. MR.. BAKER CALLED THE E.P.A. THEY ADVISED TO DIG THE AREA APPROX. 18 INCHES DEEP AND TO MAKE LIKE A POOL OUT OF VISQUEEN AND TO PUT THE GRAVEL AND DIRT ON THE VISQUEEN TO LET IT AIR OUT AND TO LEAVE IT LIKE THIS FOR AT LEAST 4-6 DAYS. MRS. JOHNSON WAS ADVISED OF THIS. AS OF 9-30-2000, IN THE MORNING, THIS HAD BEEN DONE.
