Re: Oil Spill on 4/12/01

At about 1400 hours on Thursday April 21, 2001 I received a page from Fairfield Communications asking for any EMA personnel to call. I called right away and was informed that Chief 560 (Greenfield Fire) was requesting one of us at his location. I was also informed that he was on the scene with one of his engines at an oil spill. The spill was located at the intersection of County Rd 17 (Pleasantville Rd) and State Route 158 (Lancaster-Kirkersville Rd). Upon arrival a truck from ODOT was spreading sand on the road and brushing it. Upon talking with Chief 560, I found out that the spiller was not on the scene and apparently was unaware of the spill. The spill was spread over an area of approximately 75 feet in a North to South direction. The spill was in the southbound lane of SR 158 just North of CR 17. The spill was definitely oil. We determined that it was used motor oil. The spill did get into the ditch line a slight bit but was contained by Greenfield firefighters. I determined that it was approximately 5-6 gallons of liquid that covered the roadway and part of the ditch line. I was completely satisfied with the clean up efforts and did not see the need for anything further. I have attached the copy of the NIFRs report from Greenfield.
