AT APPROX. 0630 ON SEPTEMBER 20, 2001 I RECEIVED A PAGE FROM THE FAIRFIELD COMMUNICATIONS CENTER FOR A FUEL OIL SPILL AT THE CORNER OF ST. RT. 158 AND 204.

BILL BROBST HAD ALREADY RESPONDED TO THE SCENE ALONG WITH BASIL JOINT FIRE, THE SPECIAL OPS TEAM WAS ALSO DISPATCHED BUT THEN WERE CANCELLED. I CALLED BILL AND HE STATED HE NEEDED TO LEAVE THE SCENE AND ASKED IF I COULD RESPOND TO THE SCENE. I RESPONDED TO THE SCENE AND REPORTED TO THE IC AND BILL AND RECEIVED THE REPORT OF WHAT HAD HAPPENED.

FROM THE REPORT IT IS STATED THAT CYNTHIA HEIMERZ OF 2616 BLACKLICK RD. MILLERSPORT OHIO 43406 HAD RAN THROUGH THE STOP SIGN HEADING WEST ON ST. RT. 204 AND INTO AN ONCOMING PICKUP TRUCK. HER VEHICLE PROCEEDED TO STRIKE A FUEL OIL TANK BESIDE THE RESIDENCE OF MARK MYERS 11995 LANCASTER-KIRKERSVILLE RD. THE CONTENTS APPROX. 100-150 GALS. SPILLED ONTO THE SOIL AROUND THE TANK CAUSING THE FUEL TO SATURATE THE AREA ON THE NORTH SIDE OF THE HOME. THIS SOAKED INTO THE SOIL AND INTO THE BASEMENT OF THE HOME. BASIL JOINT FIRE RESPONDED TO THE ACCIDENT.

BILL HAD ALREADY CALLED THE STATE EPA AND MIKE DALTON WAS RESPONDING TO THE SCENE. BASIL FIRE WAS TAKING CARE OF THE SCENE AND BILL BROBST LEFT AND RICK HOFFMAN BECAME FFCOEMA REPRESENTIVE. BILL HAD ALSO CONTACTED THE DRIVERS INSURANCE CO TO GET APPROVAL FOR A CLEAN UP CONTRACTOR AND BY THE TIME I LEFT WE HAD NOT GOT A CALL BACK FROM PROGRESSIVE INS. CLAIM # 017103700.

MIKE DALTON ARRIVED AT 0830 AND TOOK OVER THE ASSESSMENT OF THE SCENE. HE CLEARED THE FIRE DEPT AND MIKE AND I SURVEYED TOGETHER THE SCENE. HE CLEARED ME AT 1030 AM AND WAS WAITING FOR THE INSURANCE CO. TO CALL HIM BACK.

MIKE WILL BE FAXING HIS REPORT TO ME WHEN IT IS FINISHED. I HAVE REVISITED THE SCENE AND I AM SATISFIED WITH THE CLEANUP EFFORTS

I HAVE ATTACHED THE NFIRS REPORT AND A COST RECOVERY FORM FROM THE FIRE DEPT.

NOTES

Arrived to find an A/A with 2 cars involved. Red Firebird had struck an approximately 250 gallon fuel oil tank on the north side of 11995 Lanc-Kirk Rd. When vehicle struck tank it broke the fuel intake to the house. Tank was approximately half full at this time (approx 150 gallons). Fuel entered house through basement walls and up through the dirt floor of basement. Large area of fuel oil was found in basement and was entering drain and sump pump. HazMat 1 and EPA notified. Evacuated residents and shut off power to structure(at fuse panel). HazMat 1 and EPA left in charge of scene while a clean up crew is contacted.
