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## NOTES:

Upon arrival E610 found a train stopped in railroad cross with round straw bails surrounding it. The occupant of the semi had jumped from the vehicle prior to impact and was uninjured. There were hazards of electrical lines down, and a diesel tank rupture approx 1/4 mile from impact from the semi. Fairfield county special ops team called, Fairfield county EMS, OEPA, AEP, OSP and Baltimore PD all requested. Diesel leak was contained in area of origin and OEPA was handling that.
