Additional Remarks and Comments.

Top of porta-potty was submerged into pond when facility personnel arrived at facility for the first shift. The facility personnel removed the porta-potty from the pond, righting it in the process. The porta-potty holds 5 gallons of methanol/water mixture. Mixture is 75%/deodorizer and water and 25 % methanol according to Porta Kleen. Approximately 2 gallons was released to the pond. The unit was serviced on 12/19/2013.

To Whom It May Concern,

On December 22, 2013, at approximately 0745 hours, Columbia Pipeline Group (Columbia) responded to a methanol/water mixture release to water, from a blown over porta-potty, causing the top of the unit to be submerged into the facility retention pond, that was located at Columbia's Crawford Compressor Station. The address for this facility is 6175 Old Logan Road, Sugar Grove, Ohio, 43155. The porta-potty was located near the facility's retention pond, and approximately 2 gallons of a 75% water/deodorizer mixture, and 25% methanol; released into the pond. This unit was serviced two days prior to the incident, on December 19, 2013. The release was found when facility personnel arrived at the facility for their shift. The facility personnel removed the porta-potty from the pond, righting it in the process. There was no visible sheen to the pond or Stuckey Run Creek, which the pond drains into. Stuckey Run Creek drains into the Hocking River, approximately 200 yards to the west of the pond.

The spill was called into the Ohio EPA at approximately 1020 hours on December 22, 2013; and the spill number assigned by the Ohio EPA is 1312-23-2800.

The released components from the unit, are as follows: (information derived from Porta Kleen, owner of the unit):

There was no visible sheen from this release. There were no adverse human health, or environmental/safety impacts identified.

Employees at Columbia receive annual spill prevention training, and additionally, Columbia has an internal 24-hour emergency spill response telephone line to notify company personal immediately when situations like this one occur.
